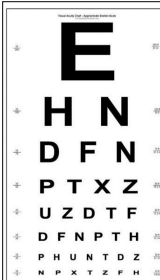
Please follow these guidelines when sending money to school.

 - what the money is for

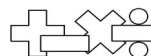
School Access Applications
