It is that time of year again when I have had a number of parents approach me and email me letters requesting specific teachers for their children. Please understand that, while in the past, parent requests were often granted it is now much more difficult to do that and maintain equitable classrooms. State and district demands related to school accountability, class size amendment and teacher evaluation based on student academic growth have made that practice impossible to create balanced classrooms.

For administration, one of the most important jobs we have is determining the most appropriate class for each child. In doing so, we first consider individual student needs based on the student's academic and behavioral history. Student's current teachers are in the process of filling out cards on each child. These cards contain academic data, information on classroom habits, children that should not be placed together and other special needs and considerations. We try to match each student with the teacher whose strengths we feel will best complement his/her needs. We then carefully balance each class in order to insure a diverse and equitable group of students for each teacher.

We will have a parent input sheet placed on our website next week. Please feel free to fill out the input sheet and return it to me by June 15th. I appreciate your understanding and your trust that we will make every student placement with a great deal of care, thought and purpose.
