We are challenging our students to continue their reading practice over the summer. Students can lose up to three months of reading progress over the summer if they do not continue to practice. It doesn't take much, 15 minutes per day can make a huge difference.

You can protect your child from summer reading loss by:

- -Reading to your child daily or have students read for a set amount of time each day
- -Reading a lot of different materials
- -Talking about what you have read
- -Asking your child questions about what was read
- -Encouraging your child to write or draw in response to what they've read

Accelerated Reader will be open over the summer for students to take quizzes and get A.R. points. A special celebration is being planned for all summer readers and a special lunch for students who read One Million Words over the summer! Our local public library located in Seagrove is here to assist students in selecting "just right" books for them. Challenge your kids to avoid "summer slide"! Keep them reading!
