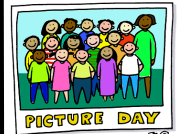

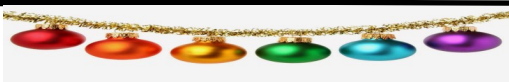

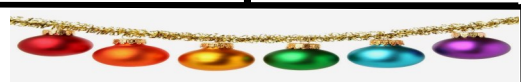


From the Desk of
