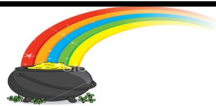

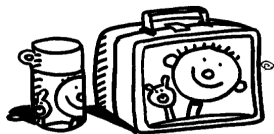
Current parents of St. Johns County School District students may file a petition for reconsideration using the form below.
