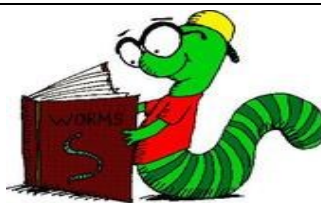


# HUNT'S CATCH-UP

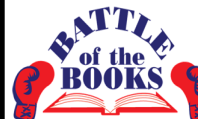
