#### FROM THE DESK OF THE PRINCIPAL...

Dear R. B. Hunt Family,

It is hard to believe, but we have been in school four weeks already. It has been a smooth start and our students are working back into the routine well. I would like to thank you parents for the outstanding job you have done getting your children to school on time this year. Attendance and tardiness are part of our school improvement plan this year. Our data from last year showed that we had 18% of our students missing over 10% of the school days, or 18 or over days of school. That is over three weeks of school! Clearly, students are unable to learn the curriculum if they are not in school. This is not to say we want children to be in school when they are sick, but when they are healthy we need them here!

Interims will be going home on Wednesday, except for grade levels that are conferencing with parents in person. We will not be printing paper report cards, unless you request one. Each report card is many sheets of paper and we feel most of you would rather look at it digitally through the Home Access Center. If you have not set up your HAC account, (Home Access Center), please do. You do not need any passwords from the school, simply login to the St. Johns County Schools website. Across the top, you will see the HAC icon, click to enter HAC and set up your account. Additional information will go home this week to help you through the process.

Remember that parking is no longer permitted on Magnolia Drive; please follow our established drop off and pick-up procedures as outlined in the Parent-Student Handbook.
