Mrs. McElhone's School Counseling Update:

Hello RB Hunt families! I hope you all have had a great start to the year!

Each month I have the opportunity to welcome each class to my room for a Classroom Guidance Lesson. I explain to the children that we not only need to develop our "school skills" to be successful in life, we also need to have strong "people skills" too! Our first classroom guidance lesson focused on conflict resolution skills. Conflict or disagreement is normal and often happens when children get together.

However, hurtful words, gestures, or physical responses are not acceptable ways to deal with conflict.

Our goal at RB Hunt Elementary is to teach students positive ways to deal with these situations. To do this, we use "Kelso's Choice Conflict Management Program". It teaches students the difference between "big" problems (problems they should get an adult's help with) and "small" problems (things they can solve all by themselves). We work hard to brainstorm ideas on how we can solve small problems in a peaceful way. This month our lesson focused on solving small(minor) problems in a peaceful way. Our October lesson will focus on big(major) problems and how we can differentiate between the two.
