

Hunts Catch Up









Dear R. B. Hunt Family,

SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM

Applications can be downloaded at any time from the website prior to April 12th at <http://www-grms.stjohns.k12.fl.us/> and click on the Marine Science link. The link also will have a complete day by day curriculum for each grade level, parent information, and a video from last year's program.

This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through seven and has been sponsored by the school district since 1982. Three eight day sessions are held at Gamble Rogers Middle School with bus transportation provided. The dates for the three sessions this summer will be May 29th through June 7th, June 10th through June 20th, and June 24th through July 3rd. Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

The Marine Science Program is a carefully designed experience for responsible students who are interested in learning about our local marine environments. Learning is "hands on" in the field with students kayaking, canoeing, boating, hiking, snorkeling, sailing, windsurfing, surfing, SUP, (stand up paddle boarding), etc. Specific grade level activities and curriculum are attached to the applications and are also available from the website.

Kindergarten and Online Registration

The St. Johns County School District (SJCS D) will begin early registration for the 2019-2020 school year March 1. This registration is only for children new to the school district, including those entering kindergarten.

Early registration can be completed online at or by visiting the student's assigned school website. To find the assigned school, enter your street address on the [Attendance Zone Locator](#). To be eligible for public kindergarten in the SJCS D, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1 and must reside in St. Johns County.

Other requirements for registration:

- Birth certificate/Guardianship Documents
 - Documentation of a health examination performed within one year of enrollment
 - Proof of completed required immunizations on Form DH680
- Proof of residence per the [Residency and Guardianship Policy](#). For additional information on registration, contact the Student Services Department at 547-7598 or the assigned school.

1. Select the JOB SEEKERS tab at the top
2. Select the AppliTrack box on the right
3. Select Substitute Bus Operator (Driver) on the left
4. Click red Apply box on the right

The online application process will take approximately 30-60 minutes to complete. In Section 4 of the application, **Vacancy Desired**, make sure the JobID 5523 (Substitute Bus Operator) box is checked. In Section 5, **Position Desired**, "Transportation" is listed. Do NOT check this box. Leave it blank. These instructions are to ensure that you are applying for the correct job opening and that your application will be seen by the Transportation Department.

PLEASE NOTE Pay extra attention to the security questions regarding background screening. To be considered for employment with the St Johns County School District you must successfully pass a high-level background check. The information provided in your online application **MUST** correspond with the results of your background check. Be sure to disclose ANY infractions, no matter how minor or long ago they may have been. A record of an infraction may not disqualify you for consideration. Failure to disclose an incident in your application, however, is reason for an employment offer to be withdrawn.
