Kindergarten and Online Registration

The St. Johns County School District (SJCSD) will begin early registration for the 2019-2020 school year March 1. This registration is only for children new to the school district, including those entering kindergarten.

Early registration can be completed online at or by visiting the student's assigned school website. To find the assigned school, enter your street address on the <u>Attendance Zone Locator</u>.

To be eligible for public kindergarten in the S.ICSD, children must

To be eligible for public kindergarten in the SJCSD, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1 and must reside in St. Johns County.

Other requirements for registration:

- Birth certificate/Guardianship Documents
- Documentation of a health examination performed within one year of enrollment
- Proof of completed required immunizations on Form DH680
 Proof of residence per the <u>Residency and Guardianship Policy</u>.
