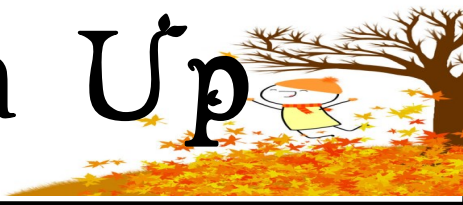


Hunts Catch Up
