2020- 2021 Fire Prevention Poster Contest

Happy Fire Prevention Week! It's that time of year again, and we're excited for another Fire Prevention Poster Contest! This year's theme is "Serving Up Fire Safety in the Kitchen!" Two winners will be selected from the



city's elementary schools- one to represent $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ and $\mathbf{2}^{nd}$ grade and one to represent $\mathbf{3}^{rd}$ and $\mathbf{4}^{th}$ grade.

The two overall winners will:

Be deemed Fire Marshal (1st or 2nd grader) or Fire Chief (3rd or 4th grader) for the entire year.

Be picked up from school in the morning by the fire engine, brought to the station for an awards ceremony and to spend the morning with the firefighters, fed lunch from Chick-fil-A, and returned to school in the fire engine.

Receive a trophy.

Have their posters framed and displayed at the fire station for one year next to a permanent plaque with their names.

Please submit four posters to represent your school- two from each category of Fire Marshal and Fire Chief. We will pick up your four posters on Friday, October 16th by 2pm, and they will be brought back to the fire station where the firefighters will choose two overall winners. On the back of each poster should be the letter A (for grades 1 or 2) or B (for grades 3 or 4), the name of the school, and the name of the teacher. Do not list the child's name.

Rules: Poster must be on standard (22" x 28") poster paper, poster must be done by the student only, and any student whose parent is a St. Augustine Fire Department employee is not eligible.

The awards ceremony will be held on Friday, October 23rd at 10:00 am at our main fire station- 101 Malaga Street. Students will be picked up from school at 9:30 am.
