

The link also will have a complete day by day curriculum for each grade level, parent information, and a video from last year's program.

This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through seven and has been sponsored by the school district since 1982. The dates for the sessions this summer will be June 14th through June 24th and June 28th through July 8th (Monday-Thursday). Small classes of 12-15 students are separated by grade level.
