Valentine's Day will kick off our "Souper" Bowl of Caring. During the week of the 14th, students will be challenged to bring in non-perishable food items and travel-sized hygiene products to support the work of St. Francis House in St. Augustine. The St. Francis Housing Crisis Center provides a residential program for homeless youth, single adults, and families

Here's how it works:

- The stage in the cafeteria will be decorated for the AFC vs. NFC football league competition
- Have your class decide which team your class will represent (e.g., NY Giants—NFC). Students will place your class donations on their respective team's side of the stage.
- Students will bring in donations to class each morning.
- Teachers will tally up all food items per day and put that daily number in an Excel shareable file.
- Each day have a few of your students bring down all of your classroom's donated items to the cafeteria and place them on the stage.
- Winners will be announced Friday, February 18th.

Needed items:

- Canned food
- Non-perishable lunch items (for bagged lunches)
- Individual-sized snack items (e.g., small chip bags, granola bars, etc.)
- Travel-sized hygiene products (e.g., shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush)

Prizes are outlined below:

- Grade Level: Extra recess period with ice cream
- Classroom: Class pizza party in the cafeteria on the stage
