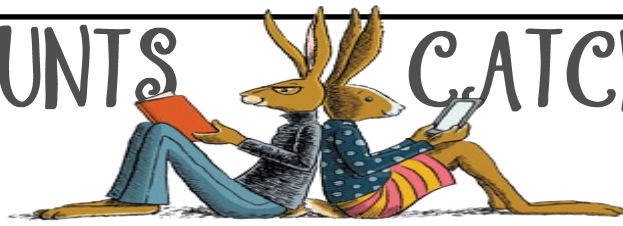


HUNTS CATCH UP

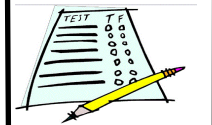

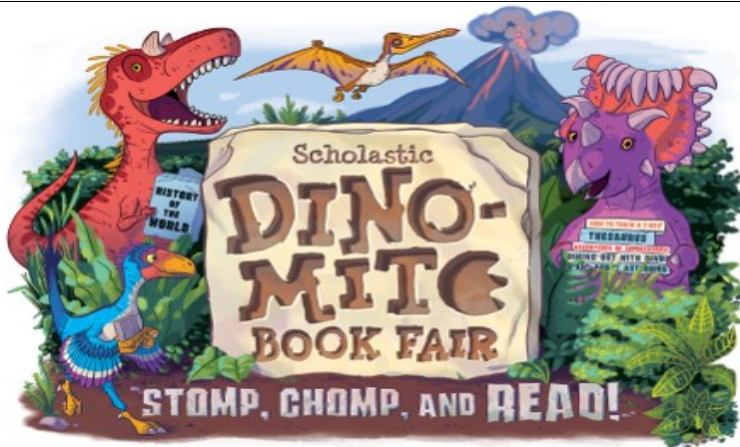
